- ❖ If you are interested in furthering your education to prepare for a job in the **Health Care field**, you should continue reading....
- ❖ Many Post secondary schools offer training for LPN, CNA, RN, Health Care Aides, Occupational and Physical Therapy, Medical Office Technology and more. These classes can be difficult if you are not prepared.
- ❖ The Northwest Tri-County Intermediate Unit is offering a **10 week** class to help you be more successful when you enroll in the Postsecondary programs. This class is **Free** to the student. It will have limitations on enrollment.
- ❖ The class is titled, “**Preparation for Health Service Occupations**” and is designed to offer Units of Instruction that will provide overviews of the many topics you will need to know about when you enter a Postsecondary training program. The class will operate for ten weeks and provide **twenty (20) class hours per week of instructional activities**.
- ❖ Topics include: Personal Assessment for Health Care Aptitude; Overview of health care occupations; Medical terminology; Basic anatomy; Stages of human development; Interpersonal skills in the Health care field; Writing skills needed for healthcare, Math skills needed for health care; Postsecondary school readiness skills; and Job preparation skills.
- ❖ All students that enroll will be required to attend an Orientation Session.

- ❖ Classes will be held on **Monday and Wednesday, January 12 to March 18, 2009: DAYTIME** from **9:00 a.m. till 2:00 p.m.** and **EVENINGS** from **4:00 p.m. till 9:00 p.m.**
